Registration Times:

3:00 p.m. – Registration Opens 5:00 p.m. – Registration Closes. 5:15 p.m. – Mandatory rules briefing begins. At least one (1) team member MUST attend.

All anglers must be off the water by 3:00 p.m. on the day of the rules meeting.

Fish Limits

Creel: 5 fish per team. 14 inches and over.

Any fish presented for weigh-in which fails to measure the official length limits shall accrue penalties at the rate of one (1) pound for each non-legal fish plus loss of the fish.

An 8-ounce deduction will be made for each fish presented to the bump master for weighing that is determined to be non-releasable.

All anglers must have a valid Arkansas Fishing License

NO INFO Rule goes into effect on Sunday, prior to the first tournament day of the National Championship event. Beginning on that Sunday you may only fish with your registered partner, you may NOT fish with a guide and you may only talk "Fishing" with other NBAA contestants in this event.

The lake will go off-limits at 3:00 pm Tuesday except during official Tournament hours.

Required Safety Equipment

It is the responsibility of all anglers to have required state and federal safety equipment on board.

At time of inspection each morning, be prepared to display 1 life jacket for each angler; 1 throwable PFD; and, demonstrate functioning kill switch.

Inspection will be held during lineup for takeoff. Live wells must be empty.

All anglers must have a valid Arkansas Fishing License in their possession covering the dates of the event. State law will be followed concerning Alabama Rigs.

Boundaries

The tournament waters for this event shall be Lake Dardanelle only and shall include all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the above-mentioned waters. Any waters within these boundaries posted "off limits" or "no fishing" by state or federal agencies will be off limit. Any live release areas established by the Tournament Director will be off limits. That as well as any additional off limits will be announced at the pre-tournament briefing. Only that water open to all public fishing will be considered tournament waters. waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's contestants. All local, state and federal regulations apply.
